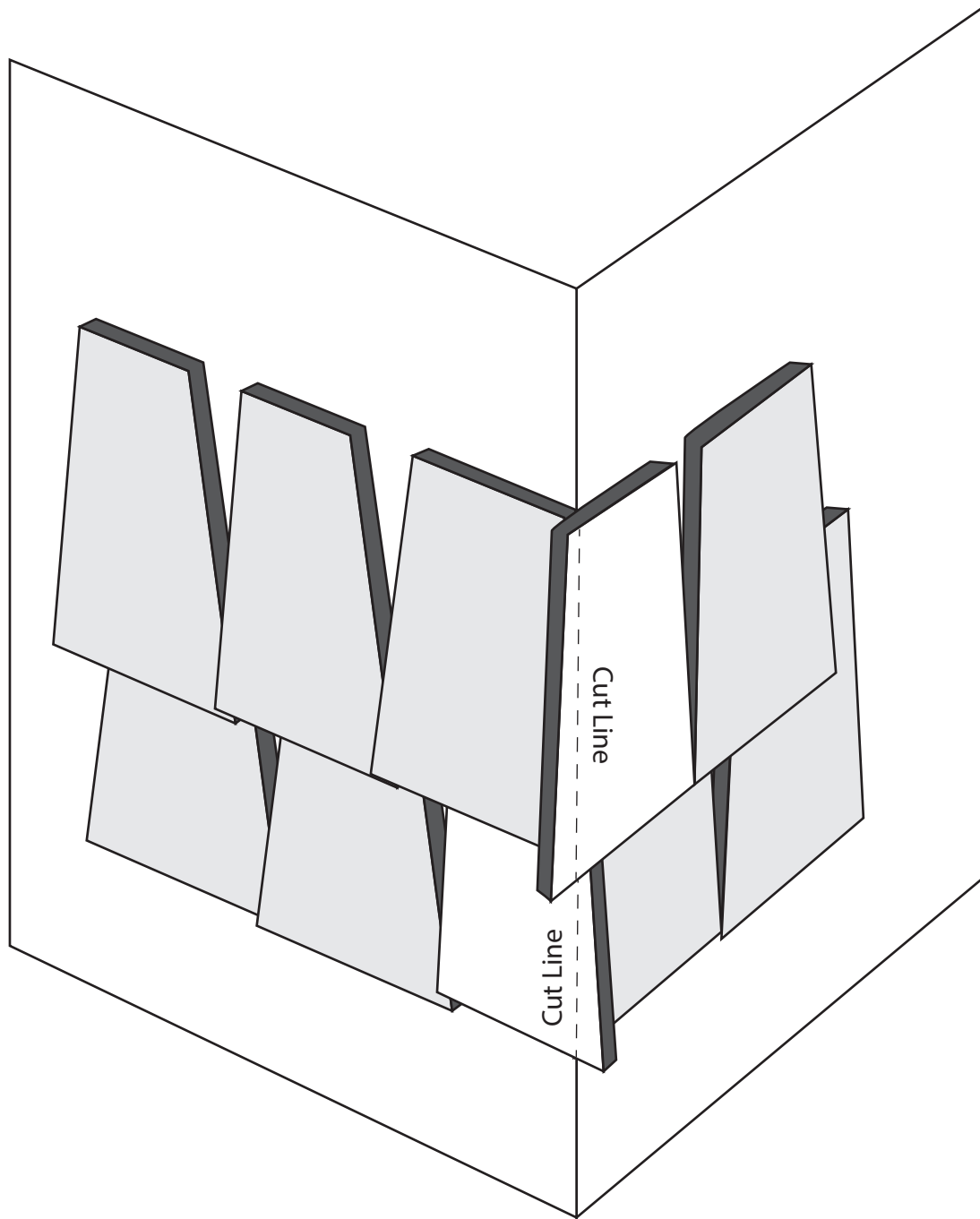


# The Boston Weaved Corner



The Boston weaved corner (also called a laced or woven corner) is achieved by overlapping every other siding courses with their adjoining wall counterparts. Create this look by nailing both courses in place, then trimming off the excess material. You can make the cuts with a utility knife or jig saw. When this technique is used the end grains of every other piece is left exposed and should be painted using the paint daubers included with your shingles.
